Save the stranding Rohingya Boat People

Our organization, JARO is immensely aware regarding the calamitous incidents of the stranding Rohingya boat-people who were being dealt afar from the international norms by the Thailand law compelling the Navy officials and advise the Royal Thai government authorities to contend with the Rohingya boat-people who are in search of sanctuary as they ran away from their native soil of Arakan. This was owing to the fact that some rational terror of persecutions, forced labour and other forms of discrimination which made their lives a living hell.

The most terrible sufferers of human rights abuses in Burma are the national Rohingya community, and they are being intentionally acknowledged as stateless without any reasonable argument by the military junta. Rohingya citizens are always suffering from sluggish burning genocide and they have also been barred from any social, political and elementary rights in their own country.

This comprises of the disagreement of nationality privileges, brutal precincts on independence of movement, marriage and religious activities, forced labour, land amputation, arbitrary seizures, persecution, extrajudicial killings and extortion on daily basis. These impossible situations have forced the Rohingya people for leaving their grates and homes seeking protected haven and an enhanced life for them and their children.

We, the members of JARO are seriously concerned about the ruthless aggression of the Royal Thai security forces towards those innocent Rohingya's. By force and harsh language assault they are throwing them all to the wide open sea leaving them on their own luck without supply of food and water. According to news from some faithful sources one of these engineless boats sank to the sea causing death and a missing toll of about 300 people. The Royal Thai security forces are completely neglecting the international law and other national standards. Every nation should be concerned about HUMAN RIGHTS. The whole world is conscious about the condition and sufferings of the Rohingya's. Still we are daunted by the treatment of the Thai Security Forces which is completely not excusable.

JARO and the respected members and supporters demand the Government of Thailand to ensure the safety of those remaining innocent Rohingya peoples and “NOT” to send them back to Burma as their lives are more in danger there. So we earnestly stipulate for a better and secured shelter for them. We would like to invite all the Rohingya’s throughout the world to be concerned with full attention to this matter for our national cause.
